Welcome to Imsook and Loma. The Year 3 students have enjoyed learning about magnetism, and have had great fun investigating using magnets in their class. This is the final week of the 'Feel the Force' topic in IPC. Next week

Year 3 start their new topic called 'Active Planet'. The students look forward to sharing some of our work with you in the future. Year 4 students have started their new topic 'Active Planet'. They have understood that the tectonic plates that form the Earth's crust are always moving, and even the smallest movement can cause huge earthquakes, volcanic eruptions and tsunamis that devastate communities across wide areas. Year 6 conducted some interesting experiments about light. The students made predictions and recorded their observations. First, the students drew an arrow. Then, they looked at the arrow through a glass of water. Amazingly, the arrow changed direction! The light bends once when it travels through the glass cup into the water, and then it bends again when it travels out of the glass cup and into the air. As a result, the light paths cross and the image appears to be flipped!
